## Community Quilts

Community Quilts is an outreach group of the Bluewater Quilters' Guild that receives requests from local non-profit or charitable organizations to provide quilts for individuals and families they support.

Twice a week, a group of quilters from the Bluewater Quilters' Guild gather at Pauline's Place, the Guild's Quilting Studio, to make these quilts with donated fabric.

Ongoing projects include donations of comfort quilts to Brightshores Cancer Centre for people receiving cancer treatments, "Sensory Activity" quilts for the Alzheimer Society and twin size bed quilts for Brightshore Health System's Wellness and Recovery Centre.
